9:00 a.m. – Mandatory Safety Meeting

9:15 a.m. – Shooting Begins

12:00 p.m. – Lunch, Awards, Raffles & Silent Auction

Around 2:00 p.m. – Event Concludes

Who can participate?

Everyone is welcome! Whether you're an experienced shooter or a first-time participant, you'll enjoy a fun day of friendly competition, great food, and fellowship. Youth shooters may register if they have their own Hunter's Safety Course Certification. YCA requires that each youth shooter be accompanied by a guardian on the course.

Can I register as an individual?

Yes! Individual shooters are welcome. We'll do our best to place you on a team if you aren't registering with one.

How many shooters are on a team?

Teams consist of **four shooters**.

How do I register and purchase add-ons?

Shooter and team registration is available through the **Aiming for Excellence Clay Shoot webpage**. Sporting Raffle tickets and Shooter Add-Ons are purchased separately from shooter registration to help us keep everything organized.

We're also offering a **NEW Shooter Add-On Bundle** this year!

Online add-on purchases will close at **NOON on Friday, October 23**, but add-ons may still be purchased in person before the shoot begins.

When is the registration deadline?

Teams may register until the event; however, registering by **October 1** ensures you'll receive event information in advance and your preferred event T-shirt size. Anyone registering after October 1 will receive available T-shirt sizes and event items while supplies last.

What is included with registration?

Your shooter registration includes:

- Sporting clays course
- Breakfast tacos & coffee
- Lunch with a live performance by **Cooper Green (@coopergreenmusic)**

- Event T-shirt
- Ammo shell pouch with swag
- Commemorative team photo printed on site by **Fonzie Munoz Photography**
- Friendly team competition
- Access to raffles, silent auction & vendors

Do I need to bring my own shotgun?

Yes. Shooters should bring:

- Shotgun & ammunition
- Eye & ear protection
Basic eye and ear protection will also be included in shooter swag pouch
- Golf cart/ATV for navigating the course

Don't have a cart? A **4-seater golf cart may be rented for \$120** through our event partner. **Rental purchase link coming soon!**

What is the Shooter Add-On Bundle?

For one discounted price, shooters can purchase a **Shooter Add-On Bundle** that includes:

- **6 Mulligans**
- **1 Annie Oakley Competition Entry**
- **5 Event Day On-Site Raffle Tickets**

Purchasing the bundle saves each shooter **\$30!**

Is the Sporting Raffle included in the Shooter Add-On Bundle?

No. The **Sporting Raffle** is separate from the **Event Day On-Site Raffle** and requires its own ticket purchase. Sporting Raffle tickets are **\$50 each**, and only **250 tickets** will be sold—so don't miss your chance!

Will there be prizes?

Yes! **Award buckles** will be presented to:

- **1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Teams** – Each team member receives their own buckle
- **A, B & C Top Shooters**
- **Top Female Shooter**
- **Top Male Shooter**

Will food be provided?

Yes! Breakfast tacos and lunch are included with shooter registration.

For lunch, shooters will enjoy a variety of delicious options prepared by our **Cooking Competition Teams**.

Travelin' Tom's Coffee will provide complimentary house coffee during breakfast, with additional specialty coffee options available for purchase throughout the morning.

Will drinks be available?

Yes! Complimentary coffee will be available during breakfast, with additional beverages available throughout the event.

Hospitality Carts will also travel along the shooting course to provide beverages to shooters and volunteers.

Can I purchase raffle tickets at the event?

Yes! During the event, you'll have several opportunities to win:

- **Event Day On-Site Raffle Tickets – \$20 each**
- **Sporting Raffle Tickets – \$50 each** (*only 250 available*)
- **Silent Auction will be online ONLY from Mon, Oct 19 – Fri, Oct 23 NOON.**

Will there be vendors?

Yes! Several local businesses and event partners will be on-site throughout the day.

We're excited to introduce our **Cooking Competition**, featuring local cook teams preparing delicious samples while competing for top honors!
